

AVOID LEGAL CLAIMS

Our judicial system has found a new reason to award large amounts of money to plaintiffs. The courts have increasingly found that mold is a primary cause of a variety of illnesses. A recent judgement awarded the plaintiff \$558,000. In addition to potential litigation, mold and mildew can negatively affect customer satisfaction by causing odors and discoloring grout joints in showers. Installing a slope to the drain under a waterproof membrane will allow moisture to escape and eliminate bacterial contamination, a major cause of mold.

The Uniform Plumbing Code (UPC) requires a slope of 1/4" per foot to the drain under the waterproofing in shower receptors. The trade responsible for installing the shower pan should create the slope. However, you should insure that a proper slope exists prior to the installation of tile.
