

# ***Food Grade Propylene Glycol & Glycerin***

The handling and storage of propylene glycol or glycerin will determine whether these products meet the stringent specifications of a food grade product.

You must first start with a certified food grade product. Then all the regulations for uncontaminated shipping, storage and handling must be followed. (Ref: White Room) If these products are used as an antifreeze or heat transfer fluid, they must be used in a system that is specified for use in the food industry to maintain food grade status. If any one of these criteria is not met, you no longer can consider the fluid “food grade.”
